Wishing you good health, happiness, and success in 2020!!!



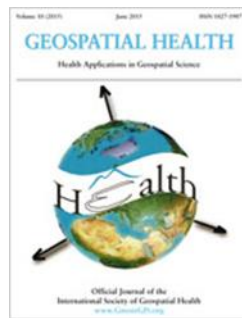
