## REPORT: GNOSISGIS@ICOPA 2018 - SOUTH KOREA

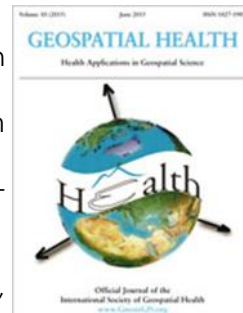
