Guideline for Abstracts

The abstract should be concise, balanced, and include the following:

- The full title of your submission (max 50 words)
- Your abstract (400 500 words, including: background, objective, method, results, and conclusions).
- Name(s) and affiliation(s) of author(s)
- Name and email address of presenting author

Guideline for Posters

Posters should be printed A1 size, with an easy-to-read font with separate paragraphs for content, and a larger font for poster title and headings. Also include name(s) and affiliation(s) of authors.

Poster sessions will take place during lunches and breaks and will remain on display throughout the conference. You are responsible for printing your poster and mounting it to the poster board before the start of the conference.

Guideline for Papers

Symposium contributors are invited to submit:

Full-paper submissions (4000 to 6000-word manuscript) of original and unpublished scientific research. High-quality submissions will be accepted for presentation at the conference, and after peer-review, can be published in our journal Geospatial Health.

Short paper submissions (2000 to 3000-word manuscript) of original and unpublished research work. High-quality submissions will be accepted for presentation at the conference and, after peer-review, can be published in our journal Geospatial Health.

Deadline for submission of short and full papers is 8 January 2024.
