

AN ONTOLOGY FOR GEOHEALTH

In this half-day workshop, we aim to co-create an initial version of an ontology for Geospatial Health domain via discussion with interested experts active in this field. An ontology is a graphical representation of a scientific domain, consisting of concepts that belong to this domain, including the relationships that exist between these concepts. An ontology of the GI-Science domain (for details [see](#)) already exists.
